

What in the World is a Cemetery Tour?

This event is an exciting and fun glimpse into the past! Tour guides lead guests to the final resting places of historic local figures, set in the beautiful greenery of Fairhaven Memorial Park and Santa Ana Cemetery.

There, costumed actors play out scenes from personal stories and interesting moments of Orange County history. Small groups, a lovely outdoor setting, and close access to the actors make the tour an entertaining outing for the whole family. History displays, and sales of books and other items complete the tour.

TOUR TIPS

- Space is limited; advance reservations are recommended by October 14th
• Tickets will be picked up at check-in on the day of the tour
• You'll be contacted by phone or email only if your first time selection is not available
• While not strenuous, this is an outdoor walking tour of approximately 90 minutes on unpaved surfaces; a hat or sunshade and comfortable shoes are recommended
• Tour will be held rain or shine
• Please make a note of your tour time and arrive 15 minutes in advance
• Free parking available at Fairhaven Memorial Park. Fairhaven is located at 1702 Fairhaven, between Tustin Avenue and Grand in Santa Ana
